

RENATO CORINO – Barolo DOCG del comune di La Morra

Red wine 75 cl

Region: **Piedmont** - Vines: **Nebbiolo**



In this wine there are hints of cinnamon and smoke, align perfectly with cherry and strawberry, followed by notes of mint, oregano and orange peel.

Type: Still red wine

Region: Piedmont

Area: Comune di La Morra (CN)

Vineyards: Nebbiolo

Vinification: Fermentation takes place in stainless steel tanks, with controlled temperature for about one week. Malolactic fermentation is completed in barrel. Ageing is carried out for 24 months in wooden barrels of different ages and in bottles as required by law. No filtration is carried out.

Description: Grenade red color.

Perfume: Hints of cinnamon and smoke line up perfectly with cherry and strawberry, followed by notes of mint, oregano and orange peel.

Taste: On the palate it is rich, intense, round and with excellent persistence.

Combination: Excellent with refined dishes, it is ideal with red meat and game.

Serving temperature: 18°/20°
